ARE YOU RIGHT FOR A SURF & SERVICE TRIP?

IMPORTANT: You must plan to rent a car in order to safely visit Rincón at this time. Some services may still be limited or unavailable during the recovery period. You'll be a great fit for a Surf & Service trip if:

-You're prepared to visit, surf and volunteer in a recovering disaster area. -You will come prepared to be "off the grid" or on limited generator power. -You will bring basic supplies to meet your own needs and help others.

Limited Services Disclosure:

Casa Verde is currently open with limited services, operating on a generator from <u>12 Noon til 12</u> <u>Midnight</u>. It is not on 24 hours a day. While the generator is operating you will have access to hot showers, satellite TV, limited A/C, coffee, and a microwave. Our restaurant Kahuna Burger Bar will be open with a limited menu (burgers, sandwiches, wings, etc.), fully stocked bar and satellite television. Security of our guests is very important and we will continue to maintain 24-hour security. Our GM (Pedro) is also residing at the Hotel to address any concerns during your stay.

NOTE: Some of our hotel amenities have been affected by the disaster, including:

-Swimming Pool (re-opening scheduled for November 10, but not guaranteed) -Maid Service (limited to every 3 days)

-Internet and Telephone (unavailable at the hotel / limited availability 'in town')

-On-Site Credit Card Processing. (Credit Card payment for rooms are accepted only when booking through Rincon Surf School) *Local payments (food/drink, etc.) are cash-only.*

RINCON SURF RESORT AT LAS PALMAS (Re-Opening Thanksgiving 2017)

Located near Sandy Beach with a private well, generator power and more. -Inquire about pre-reserving rooms for Thanksgiving and December dates.

We have a full quiver of hard-top and soft-top longboards, funboards and more. -Group Lessons - \$95 Per Person (3 Hours, Board Rental Included) -Private Group Lessons - \$120 Per Person (3 Hours, Board Rental Included) -Solo Private Lessons - \$165 Per Person (3 Hours, Board Rental Included) Additional discounts apply for multiple sessions and multiple days.

PACKING & SUPPLY LIST

- Electronics: Cell Phone, Solar Charger / Battery, Flashlight, 'Off Grid' Communication Device (Walkie Talkies or Rental Satellite Phone), AC/DC Power Inverter for car charging.
- Water: Filtration Bottle (<0.1 micron) and Water Purification Tablets.
- Food: High-energy snacks, nuts, dry meals, etc. If you don't eat it, donate it!
- Cash: Sufficient for all expenses. Credit card acceptance is limited.
- Medication & Insect Repellent (DEET) : Supplies in pharmacies are limited. Bring extra.
- Clothes: Board Shorts/Swimsuit, T-Shirts, Sandals; in addition to long sleeve cotton shirts/pants and close-toe shoes, especially if engaging in outdoor volunteer efforts.
- Tools: If you have special skills, bring the tools of your trade and replacement parts. This may include hammers, drills, bits, saws, saw blades, machetes, medical kits, etc.
- Relief Supplies: Many people still lack access to power and clean water. Bring extra water purification tablets, water filters, portable solar chargers, baby wipes, etc.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

 - -Groups "tagging homes" in remote areas; searching for people in need.
 - -Roof repair crews; tarping and making temporary roof repairs.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Many relief opportunities have specific hours or required skills. Some are limited to adults. Contact us for more information.
